

Hold the device at an angle of 30° to 60° from the face.



The nasal aspirator will only work when you press the first or second gear button.

Precautions:

Children should not play with the appliance. Cleaning and use shall not be made by children without supervision.

The nasal aspirator may only be used for the purpose for which it was designed and in the manner specified in the instructions for use. Any form of improper use can be dangerous. The manufacturer is not liable for damage resulting from improper or incorrect use.

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. To start treatment, proceed as follows:
- 2. Check the device is functioning correctly with good air tightness.
- 3. Hold or place the child to be treated in an upright position or in a position where they are leaning slightly backwards. Do not use the device when the child is lying down.
- 4. During the treatment, hold the device at an angle of 30° to 60° from the face.
- 5. The nasal aspirator will only work when you press the first or second gear button. If the child feels discomfort or pain, stop using the device immediately.
- 6. Stop using the device once the nasal secretion container is filled up to the "MAX" line.
- 7. To stop the device, release the button. Clean the device after each use.

CONTRAINDICATIONS:

- Do not use the device on people with nosebleeds.
- Do not use the device on people with acute head, facial or neck injuries.
- Do not use the device on people with coagulation or blood disorders.
- Do not use excessive force when inserting the silicone tips into the nose.
- Do not use any additional parts that are not recommended by the manufacturer.
- Under no circumstances may liquid enter the device. Protect the device from impacts, moisture, dirt, marked temperature fluctuations and direct sunlight. Do not drop the device.
